Driving Directions to Munyamadzi Game Reserve, Zambia

If you have a vehicle GPS system we can send you the route from Nyimba to make sure you don't get lost.

- 1. From Lusaka take the GREAT EAST ROAD T4 to NYIMBA. You will drive 220 km on good tar through the small towns of Chongwe, Chinyunyu and Rufunsa before reaching Luangwa Bridge.
- 2. The Luangwa bridge to Nyimba is about 110 km or an hour's drive.
- 3. When coming from Lusaka you will pass a local market on the left as you enter Nyimba. Just after the market you turn left at the sign to Nyimba Hospital. Continue on this dirt road for approx. 8 km until you get to a fork with a big cell tower on your left.
- 4. Take the left fork.
- 5. Continue on main dirt road about another 20 km until next fork.
- 6. Take the right fork.
- 7. Continue for another 15 km where you get to AMBO school signpost.
- 8. Keep right and road splits again after about 50 meters.
- 9. Keep right again and follow main graded road for about 2 km until you get to ZAWA/DNPW scout post.
- 10. Go strait through 7 km until you get to end of the road where you should see the Luangwa River in front of you.
- 11. Turn right and you enter through Munyamadzi Gate.
- 12. Follow graded road for about 18 km and you arrive at Munyamadzi main camp.

Note:

- Total distance from Lusaka to Munyamadzi main camp is approximately 380 km
- From Nyimba to main camp is approximately 65 km
- The dirt road passes through many villages and settlements, please be aware of small children and pedestrians along the road
- A comfortable drive is 6 to 8 hours
- Fuel is only available at Nyimba, gerry cans are advised if you plan to do game drives
- There are few facilities en route
- Elephants and all wildlife have right of way
- GPS, map and a satellite phone are helpful
